We are honored to have you with us during this exciting event! Brother Willie Franklin, from Aubrey, Texas, is our guest speaker. He has been preaching the gospel of Christ and reaching out to those who are searching for the truth of God's word for more than forty years, and he brings a wealth of Bible knowledge, experience and compassion to us. His lessons will include, "The Riches in Christ," "The Purpose of God," "The Problem with Man," "The Place of the Church," "Pleading for Unity," and "Practicing What You Preach." Sufficient motivation is needed for anyone to want to do anything. So, why should anyone want to become a Christian? There are many good reasons, but some of the most important include the following: (1) Because it is the only way to have knowledge of God (Mat. 11:27). God has chosen His Son, Jesus Christ, as the means by which He has revealed Himself to the world. We can know God only by knowing His Son (Jn. 14:7-10). (2) Because it is the only way to come to God (Jn. 14:6). Jesus Christ is the Head of His church (Col. 1:18), which is also the only "holy priesthood" that is suitable "to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ" (1 Pet. 2:5). (3) Because it is the only way to serve others that will be acknowledged and rewarded by God (Mat. 7:21; Mk. 9:41). Anything that is worth doing is worth doing in the name of (by the authority of) the Lord Jesus Christ (Col. 3:17). Anything that is lacking authority by Christ is not worthy to be done. (4) Because it is the only way that leads to heaven (Jn. 14:1-6). God has appointed a judge, and a day in which He will judge the world (Acts 17:30-31). "We must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ" (2 Cor. 5:10; Heb. 9:27). Those who are faithful servants of Jesus Christ will receive a crown of life (Rev. 2:10; 22:5). Those who reject Him will be condemned and lost forever (Jn. 12:48; Rev. 14:9-11). (5) Finally, coming to know God by obeying the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ is the only way to avoid everlasting destruction (2 Thess. 1:7-9). Why not become a Christian? You have nothing to lose, but everything to gain.
