I'll Be A Friend To Jesus

Johnson Oatman (1856-1922) wrote the well known song that starts: "They tried my Lord and Master, With no one to defend; Within the halls of Pilate He stood without a friend." Many people want Jesus to be their friend to save them in the end. However, the relationship is not one-sided. For Him to save us, we must be a friend to Jesus. Let us consider three simple passages from the Bible that show what this means.

The first passage is John 15:14 (NKJV) which records the words of Jesus when he said: "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you." The second passage is John 14:15 which states: "If you love Me, keep My commandments." The final passage is 1 John 2:3 which says: "Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments."

Please notice all three passages deal with keeping His commandments. Without this, a person should not claim to even know Him – at least in the Biblical sense. Also, without keeping His commandments, a person's claim to love Jesus is false. That may seem harsh to certain ears but it is true based upon what the Lord Himself said. Obviously, one cannot truly be Jesus' friend if he or she does not "know" and love Him!

The third passage may cause some confusion to people who do not know the Bible well. Many souls mistakenly assume that if they are familiar with stories about the Lord they can say they know Him. In reality, all that could rightly be said is they know a little <u>about</u> Him. When God says someone knows Him it is because they understand what He likes, wants and does it (e.g., Jer. 2:8; 4:22; 9:3,24; 22:16; 31:34). This is the same thing Jesus taught about doing His will.

Think about people you consider to be true friends. What characterizes these relationships? First, we got acquainted and learned about them – their likes, dislikes, values and interests. We find that we spend time together and enjoy their company. If we truly love them, we will do things that please them. The same things are true about being Jesus' friend!
