

Ten Biblical Steps To Effective Planning and Leadership

1. **PRAY:** Acts 13:1-3; Rom. 12:12; 1 Thes. 5:17; Eph. 3:20-21; Jas. 1:5-8
 - a. Prayer must accompany our full walk with Christ.
 - b. Never underestimate the power of prayer!
2. **RESEARCH:** Eph. 5:17; Lk. 6:46; Mat. 22:29; Acts 17:11; Eph. 2:10
 - a. Identifying the work as well as the object of it is imperative to its successful completion.
 - b. To do the will of God, one must first know it.
3. **PLAN:** Prov. 20:18; 24:27; Lk. 14:25-33; Prov. 19:2; 29:20
 - a. Plan well and stick to it! Write it down in as much detail as necessary, but, be flexible enough to make adjustments for error or to accommodate new information.
 - b. Planning includes budgeting, supply, manpower, objective, etc. Also: **WHAT? WHY? WHEN? WHERE? WHO? HOW?**
 - c. Regular monthly, or bi-monthly, business meetings are essential.
4. **INFORM:** Acts 15:22-32; 20:17-21
 - a. Uninformed people are unsupportive, disinterested, and unsympathetic.
 - b. People must know what is before them and what is expected of them.
5. **INCLUDE:** Eph. 4:11-16; Neh. 4:6, 16-17; 1 Cor. 12:20-27
 - a. There is something for everyone to do, from the greatest to the least.
 - b. Take a "talent inventory" of your congregation.
 - c. Leave no one feeling left out, unwanted, unloved, unnecessary.
6. **EXHORT:** Acts 14:21-22; 1 Tim. 4:13; 2 Tim. 4:1-2; Tit. 2:15
 - a. Share your excitement! Keep the church encouraged and reminded of the work.
 - b. The apostles saw exhortation as an important work.
7. **EXECUTE:** 2 Cor. 8:10-11; Jas. 1:22-25; Mat. 7:21; Rev. 3:2
 - a. Many congregations and individuals are great planners, but like the church at Sardis they never finish their work.
 - b. The proverb is: "The highway to hell is paved with good intentions."
8. **REVIEW:** Acts 15:36; 1 Thes. 5:21-22; 2 Cor. 13:5
 - a. Constantly evaluate the condition, quality and progress of your work.
 - b. Is it remaining faithful to the word of God? Is it progressing? Are objectives being achieved? Are laborers out of service? What remains undone?
 - c. Correct errors. Reinforce successes.
9. **REPORT:** Acts 21:17-19
 - a. The congregation has a right to know about the fruits of their efforts, whether positive or negative.
 - b. Regular reporting keeps interest from flagging and allows for the setting of new goals.
10. **RENEW:** 1 Cor. 15:58; Acts 20:24; Phil. 3:13-15; Heb. 10:38-39
 - a. It must be understood that no congregation or individual stands still spiritually: the exact moment forward movement ceases, backward movement begins.
 - b. The instant a person or a church stops growing spiritually, it begins to die. Activity must be maintained, new work identified, new goals established.
 - c. A prayerful searching out of responsibility from the scripture must continue.
